Why are we learning the American Building Code?

This course is based on the NFPA Codes and Standards to appeal to a wide audience, so we follow the material in NFPA 921 and the exam banks.

The guiz questions are sometimes worded in a confusing manner.

We've written the quizzes with the intention of preparing you for the standardsbased exam questions for ProBoard accreditation.

Text books required. Do students need one or both reference books?

Either NFPA 921 or Fire Investigator Principles and Practice is fine. If you are choosing which to purchase, we recommend NFPA 921 as this will be highly valuable as you move forward in your fire investigation career.

Is there a deadline for taking the 2-day practical after completing the online portion?

You will need to attend the practicum within 12 months of taking the online portion. Don't forget to review the online material before the practicum dates.

Will this course provide the certifications for Fire Investigation Levels I. II & III?

NFPA 1033 is the Standard for Professional Qualification for Fire Investigator. Unlike some other NFPA Standard, 1033 does not have levels. Some training providers, including ourselves, have created levels to divide the training program into segments, but these are not laid out in the Standard. For candidates to receive accreditation them must meet the full standard which they can accomplish by taking the FireWise Consulting Fire Investigation Origin and Cause level I as well as Fire Investigation Origin and Cause level II.
